

ACHIEVEMENT OF THE CPSU STANDARDS IN SAFEGUARDING and PROTECTING YOUNG PERSONS July 2009

BWY is proud to have achieved, through independent verification, a recognised standard in safeguarding and protecting children. We have been working with, and receiving support from, the Child Protection in Sport Unit (CPSU - part of the NSPCC) to broaden and tighten up on the implementation of our Child Protection Policy and Procedures to a level referred to as 'Advanced Safeguarding Standards'.

On an everyday basis the new validation will probably have little effect on most BWY teachers – but it does mean that if you need to refer to our CP policy and if you use it to guide your work in specific teaching situations, you should be reassured that the content and issues it deals with are of a very high standard.
