What is my training responsibility under the BWY Child Protection Policy?

The boxes below indicate which training option to access according to your teaching circumstances. **Training should be updated every three years**

Teachers of Adult Classes

Teachers of Under 18 year olds – dedicated classes

What is the content of the training and how do I access it?

NSPCC – CHILD PROTECTION IN SPORT AND ACTIVE LEISURE

This is a flexible, self-directed training programme which can be done from home. either on-line or paper-based through Educare. The cost is approximately £30. The course was written by the NSPCC and provides an authoritative introduction to keeping children safe in sport. It is delivered in four concise modules with questionnaires to test understanding.

Module Two – Recognising Child Abuse

How to respond if a child confides in you and indicators of abuse

Module Three – Reporting Child Abuse

What to do after a child confides in you and what happens after reporting concerns

Module Four – Good Practice Issues

How individuals and organisations can develop good practice guidelines for safeguarding

SAFEGUARDING and PROTECTING CHILDREN – SportscoachUK

Three-hour workshops are run on a regular basis throughout the UK. The cost is approximately £30 but could be subsidised by the local authority.

This workshop offers an enhanced learning experience, given the face to face contact with other participants and opportunities to share experiences. The workshop covers

- Code of Conduct
- The foundations of safeguarding, good practice and child protection
- Understanding and identifying signs of child abuse
- Appropriate action to take in response to an allegation / concern
